I acknowledge receipt of your letter received by the Court on 20 February 2012 and concerning the above application.

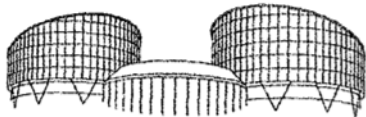

Dear Madam,

I acknowledge receipt of your completed application form of 14 November 2011, with enclosures, from which it appears that you wish to pursue the application lodged with the Court under Article 34 of the European Convention on Human Rights.

I note that despite the indications in our previous letter **you have not submitted all the information** required by Rule 47 §§ 1 and 2 of the Rules of Court. In particular you are requested to clarify whether you have lodged an administrative recourse or any other judicial proceedings before the Cypriot courts.

That being so, **the case cannot be examined by the Court**. You are therefore requested to supplement the application by submitting the missing information before **9 March 2012**.

I should emphasise that you must send the necessary supplementary documents to the Court within the above period. No extension of this period is possible. If all the relevant documents are not sent within this period, the file opened will be destroyed without further warning.
